Our programs help to stimulate creativity and build art making skills, in an environment that is safe, fun and fulfilling. Art activities are complemented by gallery tours, stories, games, and exploring the natural beauty of our 40 hectares of conservation land.

Camp Volunteer Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with studio cleaning, prep, and organization during camper snack breaks and sign out periods.
- Help oversee morning and afternoon activities. At lunch, outdoor games and other physical activity is recommended, get involved in the games and keep an extra eye out for any situations that Assistants need to attend to.
- Reinforce and model the behavioural code established by senior ArtVenture staff at all times.
- Maintain and promote enthusiasm for participation among campers and help during art making time as needed.
- Report all incidents (health or behavioural) to Assistant or Instructor.
- Help act to prevent and stop unsafe situations from arising and alert the Assistant and Staff members working with you of any dangerous situations.
- Help assistants check all lunches and snacks for peanut/allergens etc.
- Assist as needed.
- Work as a team with the Instructor and Assistant.
- BE PROACTIVE! Take the initiative to help without being asked.

Requirements:

- All camp volunteers must be pre-registered with the McMichael Youth Team with the following: Age 13 and up.
- Have completed a Vulnerable Sector Screening check. (if 18+)
- Commit to a minimum of 3 weeks of volunteering at camp.
- Assist each day of camp from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (All volunteers have a 1-hour scheduled lunch break).
- Attend a group interview session via Zoom and 1-2 days of training on June 22 & 23, 2024.
- Some experience with or strong interest in working with children.
- First Aid training is a strong preference.
- Good communication skills and ability to work with people of a wide range of ages.
- Enthusiastic and energetic.
- Creative and imaginative.
- Able to provide own transportation to McMichael Canadian Art Collection.
- Arrive on time you must be here, signed in, and ready to start by 8:30 a.m. Due to the nature of the camp we will require you to be in attendance for the full duration of their scheduled sessions.
- Be positive and engaging.
- Work as a team, effectively with the Instructor and Assistant.
